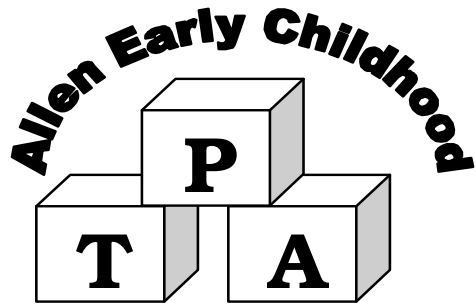

ABOUT THE AECPTA...

The Allen Early Childhood PTA is a support group for parents of children from birth through six years of age. We provide a place to meet other parents of preschoolers and to share experiences, problems, and solutions. You do not need to have your child enrolled in preschool to join the AECPTA. We are not affiliated with any specific preschool in this area. We are associated with the National and Texas State PTA.

Our general meetings are held the second Friday of each month September through May. There is no December meeting. We meet at Christ the Servant Lutheran Church, 821 S. Greenville in Allen (one block south of Bethany on Greenville). Nursery check-in starts at 9:15, a short business meeting starts at 9:30, followed by a program that lasts until 11:00. Our programs cover topics of interest and concern to parents of young children.

While you are enjoying the meeting, your child will have the opportunity to play with other children the same age. They are divided into age groups in separate rooms; infants and toddlers are cared for in a nursery filled with age appropriate toys. Older preschoolers participate in a planned program of activities including crafts, stories, and outdoor play if weather permits. There is a small fee charged to help defray the cost of the sitters.

We offer our members various services and activities that are of interest to parents of preschoolers. We have age based and multi age playgroups that meet weekly. Several field trips are planned each month. The babysitting coop provides substitute care for our children when we have to leave them. Members watch each other's children in exchange for coupons entitling them to babysitting at some future date.

In sum, we try to provide assistance to parents of preschoolers, to help them develop parenting skills, to enhance their children's early years and their overall development. We believe that parents are the first teachers and we seek to support them in that role.

AECPTA Mission Statement

To provide an open and supportive organization with a diverse membership of families with young children by developing programs and projects which support the objectives of the PTA in a safe and nurturing environment.

History

The Allen Early Childhood PTA (or AECPTA) was chartered on March 8, 1989. Our belief is that a child's first teacher is his/her parent and we at the AECPTA are here to help support parents in all areas of parenting while their children are still young. Members are parents of children whose ages range from birth to Kindergarten who need a common arena in which to share experiences, problems and solutions. The AECPTA is a community wide organization to meet the needs of families in our community.

The AECPTA is proud of its many accomplishments. We support many community service projects throughout the year. Last year donations were made to the Allen Community Outreach Center, the Allen Animal Shelter, the Allen Food Pantry and Victoria Gardens, just to name a few.

The AECPTA also provides educational programs for parents. Members as well as educators and others from the community are encouraged to attend these programs.

The AECPTA is proud of the Sunshine Committee. It is made up of individuals within the PTA who help other members during times of need such as births, deaths and emergencies.

The AECPTA is involved in many other functions and activities. We sponsor the Allen Independent School District's yearly Kindergarten Readiness Program and we participate in council and state PTA sponsored activities. Several members attend the state summer seminar, and our children participate in the PTA Reflections program.

Characteristics of a Good Preschool

- The classroom is organized in an orderly, uncluttered fashion
- The general climate is welcoming, relaxed, comfortable, cheerful, and open to exploration.
- Shelves and storage areas are clearly labeled and organized for efficient use by the children.
- Shelves are the proper size for the materials.
- Shelves and storage areas are of a convenient height and depth for the children to reach materials easily.
- Pictures are hung at the children's eye level.
- Materials are clean and in good condition. (No missing or broken parts, no marks or dirt.)
- An area is provided for quiet activities.
- There is adequate outside play area and facilities for active indoor play during inclement weather.
- Materials are changed to retain the children's interest.
- New materials are added as the children progress so that the child's interest is stimulated.
- The teacher respects individual differences.
- The teacher demonstrates to the child the correct procedure for handling materials rather than calling attention to his error.
- The teacher speaks to the children in a pleasant natural tone, avoiding a singsong or whisper tone.
- The teacher uses "please" and "thank you" as examples.
- The teacher encourages independence by having children do things for themselves or having children help each other.
- The teacher intervenes when a child is misusing the materials or is disrespectful to another.
- The teacher encourages desirable behavior rather than drawing attention to undesirable behavior.
- The teacher gives the child the opportunity to make decisions and accepts their choices within the stated limits of the class.
- Children do real things like cooking, planting seeds, or caring for animals.
- The teacher takes time to listen and answer the children.
- The teacher tells the children; by giving a signal or warning ahead of time that the work period is ending so that the child may complete his work.
- The teacher shows respect for a child's style and pace of learning.
- The teacher allows creative expression in art media without imposition of model standards, realistic representation, or adult aesthetic standards.
- The teacher is alert to the whereabouts and actions of all children at all times.
- The teacher provides for physical movement. The children are not made to sit for long periods.
- The teacher and staff conduct themselves in a professional manner at all times.
- The teacher and staff are friendly but professional with the parents.
- The children put their own materials away after each use.
- The children are not unusually quiet or overly noisy.
- The teacher-child ratio is consistent with the age of the children and the size of the classroom.
- There should be provision for supervised and comfortable isolation of any child having "suspicious symptoms" of infection.
- The center welcomes parents to observe, discuss policies, make suggestions, talk things over and perhaps participate in the work of the center.
- Cushioning materials are used to cut down extraneous noises i.e. rug under blocks, pads under knock out bench.
- There are opportunities for children to play alone, participate in a small group, and participate in a large group.
- There should be many opportunities for dramatic play: i.e. housekeeping center, dress-up clothes for boys and girls.
- There are a variety of basic visual art media such as painting, drawing, clay, finger paint, or collage.
- Music is a vital part of the program.
- Language stimulation is varied: i.e., reading books, stories, questions and answers, conversation or classification games.
- Field trips are planned to give an enlarged insight into the world around us. There is adequate preparation and follow up after the trips.
